SCORING: Comstock, 28 rounds, 140 points

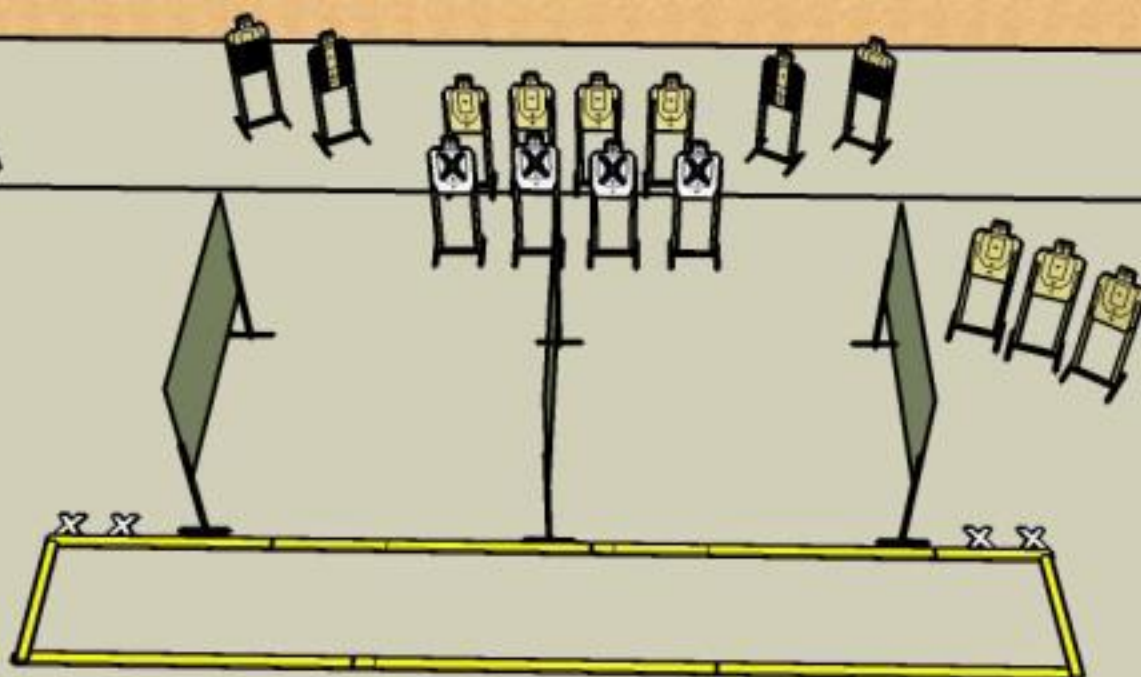
TARGETS: 14Metric

START POSITION: Standing facing down range, both thumbs pressing on pasters on the wall .

GUN READY CONDITION: Gun loaded and holstered

SCORING: Comstock, 28 Rounds, 140 points

TARGETS: 14 METRIC

STAGE PROCEDURE: On start signal, engage all targets as they become visible from within fault lines.

SCORED HITS: Best 2 per paper

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot

RULES: USPSA current edition

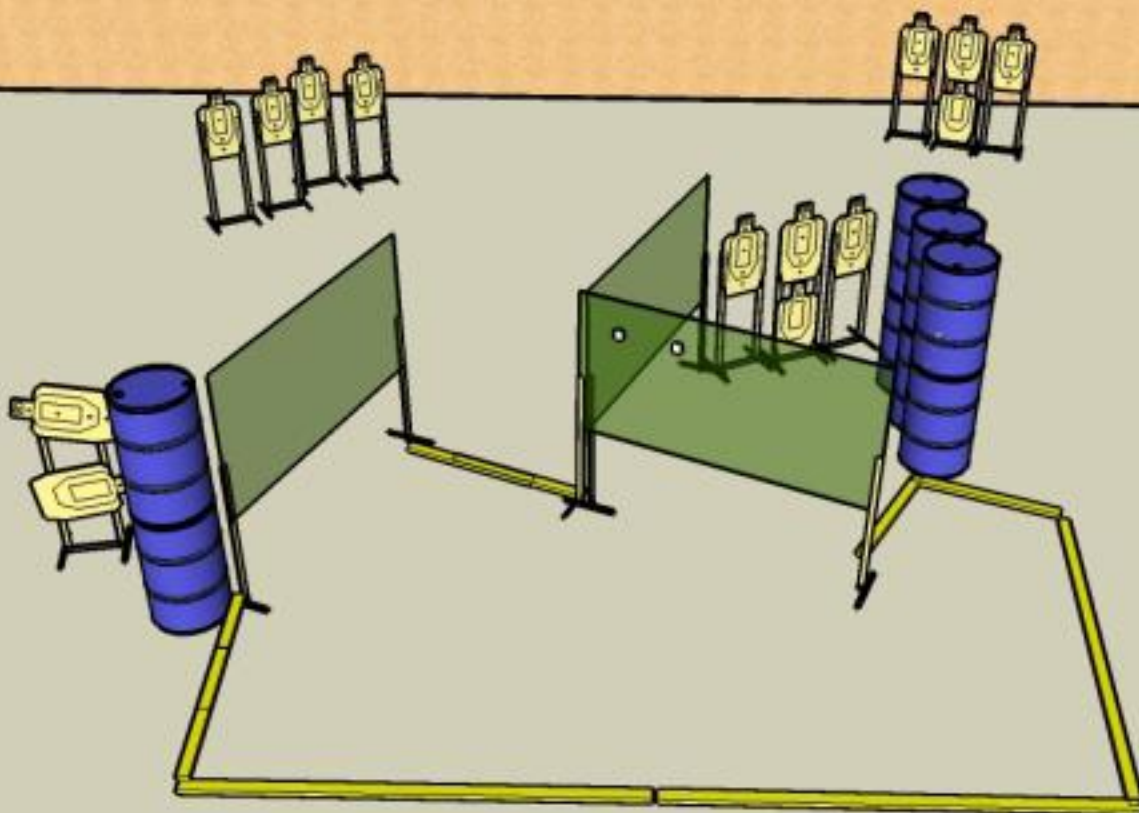




Table Start

PEARLINGTON MATCH

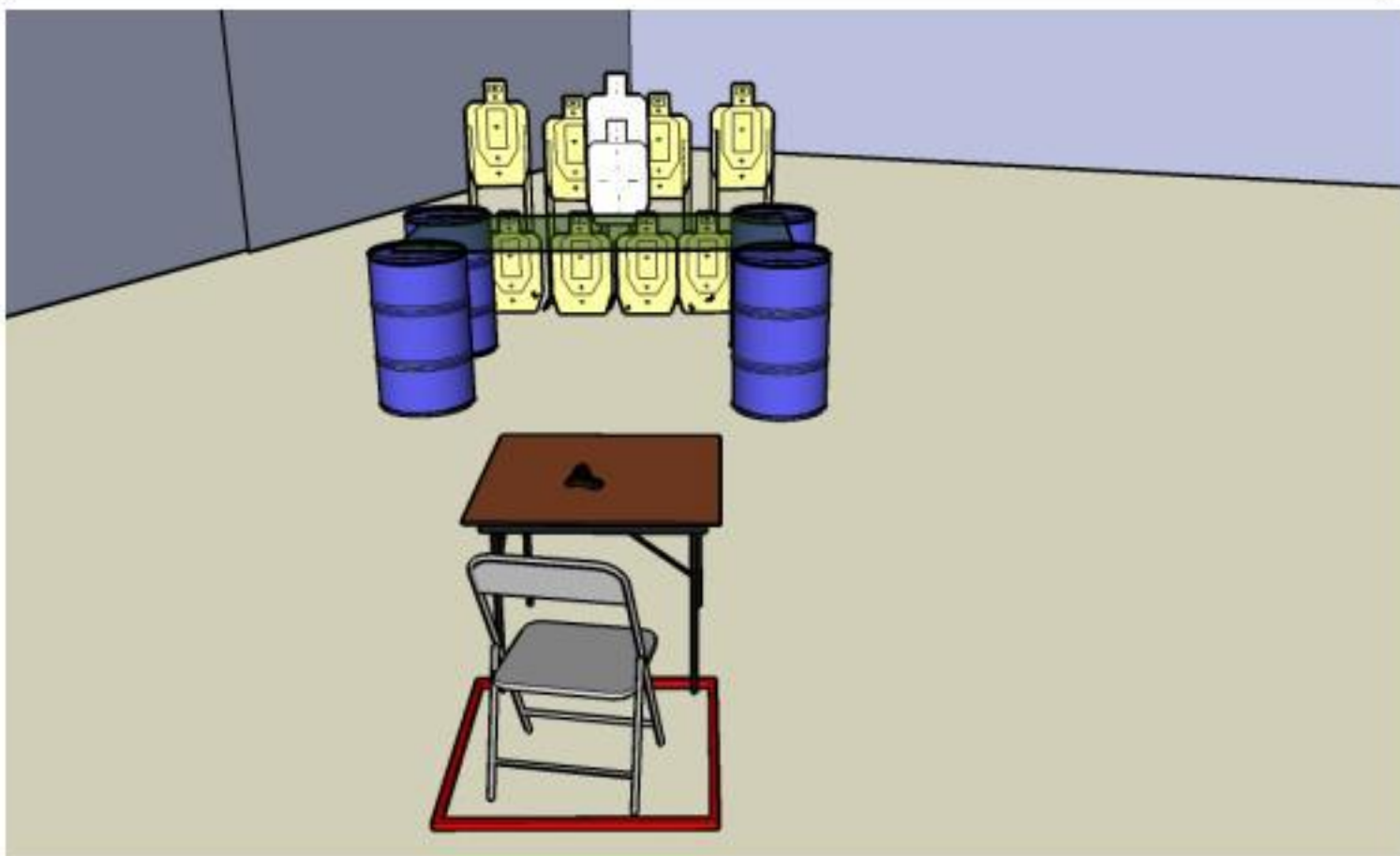
START POSITION: Sitting at table in box A, back against chair, facing down range, hands behind head, with fingers interlaced.

GUN READY CONDITION: Gun loaded, lying on table, unsupported, trigger guard over mark.
Ammo may be anywhere on table or on belt at start.

STAGE PROCEDURE: Upon start signal from box A, engage array 1. Then make a mandatory reload and engage remaining array.

Note: Separate arrays are defined as either : targets visible above the deck (4x8 sheet) or targets visible below.

SCORING: Comstock, 16 rounds, 80 points
TARGETS: 8 metric
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per paper
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
RULES: USPSA current edition

Too Close For Comfort

RULES: USPSA Handgun Competition Rules, Current Edition COURSE DESIGNER: 2005 Design Team

START POSITION: Standing facing downrange with hands relaxed at sides. Gun will be loaded and holstered.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal, draw and engage T1 - T5 with only one round each from within shooting box, make a mandatory reload and reengage T1 - T5 with only one round each from within the shooting box.

SCORING

SCORING: Virginia Count, 10 rounds, 50 points

TARGETS: 5 Metric

SCORED HITS: Best 2/paper

START - STOP: Audible - Last Shot

PENALTIES: Per current edition of USPSA Handgun Competition Rules
