
# PEARLINGTON MATCH

STAGE PROCEDURE: On start signal, engage all targets as they become visible from behind fault lines. SCORING: Comstock, 32 rounds, 160 points
TARGETS: 14 METRIC, 4 PEPPER POPPERS
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per paper KD steel for score

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot RULES: USPSA current edition

START POSITION: Standing facing down range, toes touching X's hands relaxed at sides.

GUN READY CONDITION: Gun loaded and holstered as per

USPSA rules 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE: On start signal, engage all targets as


visible from within fault lines.

SCORING: Comstock, 30 rounds, 150 points

TARGETS: 12 METRIC, 6 POPPERS

SCORED HITS: Best 2 per paper KD steel for score

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot RULES: USPSA current edition





## **Nuevo El Presidente**

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Kent Oram-Modification by US Design Team

START POSITION: Standing in Box A, back to targets, toes of both feet against rear fault line of Box A, both wrists above respective shoulders. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

#### STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal, turn, then draw and from Box A engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target. Then make a mandatory reload and from Box A engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target.

#### SCORING

SCORING: Virginia Count, 12 rounds, 60 points


TARGETS: 3 IPSC

SCORED HITS: Best 4/paper

START - STOP: Audible - Last shot

PENALTIES: Per current edition USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.

Failure to perform mandatory reload will result in one procdeural penalty per shot fired.



SETUP NOTES: Set paper targets to 5 feet high at shoulders. Box A is 3 feet by 3 feet. No-shoots are arranged on T2 and T3 with perforations of the nonscoring borders placed on the perforations of the A



zones of the targets. The top of the upper A/B zone of the no-shoot is even with the shoulder of the scoring targets.

GUN READY CONDITION: Gun loaded and holstered as

per USPSA rules 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

SCORING: Virginia count, 24 rounds, 120 points


TARGETS: 6 METRIC

SCORED HITS: Best 4 per paper
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
RULES: USPSA current edition.

#### STAGE PROCEDURE:

STRING 1: On start signal, engage each target with only one round, freestyle, then reload and engage each target with only one round, strong hand.

**STRING 2:** On start signal, engage each target with only one round, freestyle, then reload and engage each target with **only one** round weak hand.







# Back In The Boxes Stage 5

# PEARLINGTON MATCH

START POSITION: Standing in Box A, B, or C, facing down range, wrists above shoulders. (same for all strings)

GUN READY CONDITION: Gun loaded and holstered as per

USPSA rules 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

SCORING: Virginia Count, 24 rounds, 120 points

TARGETS: 4 METRIC

SCORED HITS: Best 6 per paper START-STOP: Audible - Last shot

#### STAGE PROCEDURE:

String 1: On signal, engage T1-T4 w/2 rds. each from box A.

String 2: On signal, engage T1-T4 w/2 rds. each from box B.

String 3: On signal engage T1-T4 w/ 2 rds. each from box C.
